## ATV Rides

### **Guided ATV Tour**

Re-live the “boomtown” days of Big Bend’s past as we travel through the remains of one of the area’s largest mining operations - finishing with a spectacular view of Big Bend National Park and the surrounding area! This three-hour loop tour covers many miles of desert terrain on a two-seater Bombardier All-Terrain Vehicle. Our tours are highly interpretive and offer the visitor an opportunity to learn more about the Big Bend. If you don't want to drive you, join us as a passenger!

### **ATV Treasure Hunt**

*All Riders **must** wear provided helmets, goggles and gloves. Minimum age for any rider is 8 years.*

*All Operators must be at least 16 years of age and have a valid drivers license from the state in which they reside. Riders who do not meet the age requirement to operate the ATV may ride as a second person with parent, guardian or guide. No riders under 18 are allowed on the tour without parent or guardian also being on the tour. All Participants will be required to sign an Assumption of Risk and Release of Liability Agreement. Pregnant women will **not** be allowed to ride or operate an ATV. Participants using alcohol, illegal drugs or prescription medications that might affect their ability to properly operate an ATV will not be allowed. Use of alcohol or illegal drugs during the ride is immediate grounds for expulsion from the trip without refund. All Riders must have long pants and closed toe shoes. Long sleeved shirts are preferred but not required.*

*Biking for all experience levels (Beginner, Intermediate or Advanced). Riders are measured from inseam to floor for to determine bike size. Bikes are also available with flat pedals or toe clips. We suggest wearing sunglasses, sunscreen and lip balm on your biking excursion. Wearing a helmet is **required**. Children **must** be at least 5 foot tall in order to ride.*

## **Cowboy Action Shooting & Five Stand**

### ***Cowboy Action Shooting***

Learn how to shoot the guns that won the West! Shoot a single action pistol, side-by-side shotgun, and a lever action rifle. Then have a competition to see who's the fastest. Proper western attire is mandatory--chaps and a ten-gallon hat are preferred.

### ***Five Stand (Skeet Shooting)***

A shotgun shooting game using sporting clays, the game allows shooters of all abilities some of the most exciting target combinations available in the world today. Our course utilizes eight automatic traps to simulate game birds such as dove, quail and pheasant and even a bolting rabbit across the ground. One round consists of 25 shots with groups of shots being taken from each shooting stand.

### **Closed Canyon**

While soaking in the magnificent view from the top, enjoy hot coffee and pastries made in the Lajitas Bakery. Continuing west, we'll stop for an easy, short walk into Closed Canyon. Carved by millions of years of weather and water, Closed Canyon offers a close-up look of nature's handiwork. On our way home we will make a brief stop at the movie set where "Streets of Laredo" and other major motion pictures have been filmed. Departure times vary depending on sunrise.

### **Terlingua Abaja and Luna's Jacal**

Terlingua Abaja was the original Terlingua—a Mexican farming village along the banks of Terlingua Creek. This was a prosperous community at one time, with many hundreds of inhabitants, a trading post and frontier school. Today, all that remains are a few crumbling adobe ruins, found after a drive down a narrow winding backcountry road. Luna's Jacal (pronounced Hah-cal) was home of Gilberto Luna, a Mexican farmer and rancher, who lived in the area until he was 108 years old. The old hut is typical of the type dwelling people used for centuries in these desert regions.

## **Fossil Tours**

### ***Marine Fossil Tour***

Take an hour to see something from a time when the water was all you saw on a now seemingly waterless desert. Check out the stomach contents of a Mosasaur and the fossil of a 30' duckbill dinosaur. The Guide at the Mosasaur Ranch Museum will give you a tour of the museum, show you fossils that have been collected on digs from around the Big Bend area, and then, on a short half-mile hike, they will take you to where they are currently digging for marine fossils to show you how it is done.

*River trips are conducted by Farflung Adventures. Water level of Rio Grande determines a) what Canyons will be taken b) whether raft or canoe will be used. Use of a life jacket is **required**. A waterproof bag will be provided to hold your belongings. Drinking water is provided, containers are not. The following items are recommended for your river excursion: river sandals or old tennis shoes, fast drying shorts or swimsuit, t-shirt, hat/visor, sunglasses, sunscreen, lip balm, jacket, camera and binoculars. Soft drinks and alcoholic beverages are allowed as long as not in glass containers.*

*Cancellation policy: 48-hour notice is required in order to receive a 50% refund of the deposit. Less than 48 hours deposit is forfeited. A seven-day cancellation notice is required during the weeks of Spring Break, Thanksgiving and Christmas.*
